MS4 Permit

Presentation on the changes to the MS4 Permit and MAPC technical assistance opportunities given by Martin Pillsbury, MAPC Environmental Planning Director. See presentation slides.

Review the "Regulated Area Map" by town to learn what communities or parts of communities are subject to the Phase II MS4 Program: https://www3.epa.gov/region1/npdes/stormwater/ma.html

MAPC described its work with the Neponset Stormwater Partnership (NSP). MAPC, with the NSP has developed outreach materials; completed stormwater mapping and analysis; recommended stormwater bylaw amendments; and providing guidance on stormwater management financing.

This area is a priority project area, as identified in the FY 2017 MAGIC workplan, and meeting attendees reiterated interest in working with MAPC on a regional stormwater project to support compliance with the MS4 Permit.

Motion proposed and accepted to have MAGIC Officers and MAPC develop a scope of work for regional collaborative stormwater management project to support compliance with MS4 Permit.

Climate Change Plan
