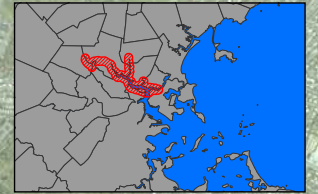

Environmental Justice Populations

Based on the following Criteria:

- Lower Income: Households earn 65% or less of the statewide household median income
- Minority: 25% or more of the residents are minority
- Foreign-born: 25% or more of the residents are foreign-born
- Lacking English: 25% or more of the residents are lacking English language proficiency

- Foreign-born residents
- Foreign-born / Lower Income / Minority residents
- Foreign-born / Lower Income / Minority / Lacking English residents
- Foreign-born / Minority residents
- Foreign-born / Minority / Lacking English residents
- Lower Income residents
- Lower Income / Minority residents
- Minority residents
