The Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC), acting on behalf of Cities, Towns and School Districts from Eastern and Central Massachusetts and the Southeast Planning and Economic Development District, Old Colony Planning Council, Merrimack Valley Planning Council, Cape Cod Commission and Central Massachusetts Regional Planning Council, seeks proposals from qualified vendors to procure seafood products appropriate to K-12 student populations, particularly from underutilized and undervalued species, that meet the needs of school districts in the participating regions. A Vendor Conference will be held on Thursday March 1, 2018 at the Metropolitan Area Planning Council offices in Boston, 60 Temple Place at 1pm. Sealed proposals will be due March 14, 2018 at 12:00 PM at MAPC, 60 Temple Place, 6th Floor, Boston, MA 02111. MAPC will be the contracting authority. A contract or contracts will be awarded to the eligible, responsive, and responsible vendor(s) identified as offering the most advantageous proposal(s). The initial term of any contract(s) resulting from this RFP will be from date of execution through March 1, 2019 with the option to renew for two additional one-year terms at the sole discretion of MAPC. MAPC reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals, or any part or parts thereof, and to cancel this solicitation at any time. No bid bond is required.

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
