On July 16, 2018, MAPC issued a Request for Quotes on behalf of the cities and towns of: Boston, Cambridge, Charlton, Concord, Lowell, Marlborough, Medway, and Newton. A revised RFQ and Addenda #1 was issued on August 1, 2018. All vendor responses were requested by 4pm on August 10, 2018. Vendors with the lowest price that met the minimum requirements and requested specifications were awarded by MAPC on **August 27**, **2018**. Table 1 contains the final pricing being offered by the awarded vendors for each station type category. "Purchase Price per unit," reflects the final unit price for the hardware and software that should be listed on purchase orders executed through this RFQ.

Green Mobility Group Purchasing Program - EV Charging Station RFQ

As per the RFQ, the Vendor's prices as defined in Table 1, must be honored for 90 days from the date in which MAPC notifies the Vendor that their pricing has been accepted (November 25, 2018). In submitting its quote a Vendor commits to meet that obligation. After that date, the awarded Vendor can continue to honor the bid price for participating municipalities but cannot be held to that pricing. As such, the participating municipalities are strongly advised to move forward with a purchase order BEFORE Sunday, November 25, 2018.

PURCHASE ORDERS & DIRECTION OF WORK

MAPC is available to assist communities with the purchase order process. As per the RFQ, The municipalities will be responsible for managing and directing the work of the selected vendor(s) for all orders initiated by a municipality. Purchase orders may be submitted directly to the awarded vendors (see contact information provided in Table 2) and must reference the Bid Number **BD-18-1217-MAP04-MAP04-29399** to receive the pricing being offered during the 90 day period.
