

NERAC18 – Communications Shelter Wiring

The Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC) on behalf of the Northeast Homeland Security Regional Advisory Council (NERAC) invites quotes from qualified vendors for the installation and connection of electrical and fiber wiring at a recently installed prefabricated communications shelter in Middleton, MA.

The work contracted for through this Request for Quotes is subject to the Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Law. Please see attached Prevailing Wage Rates.

This contract will be awarded to the responsive¹ and responsible² vendor who offers all listed services for the lowest price.

If the vendor is submitting an alternate to what has been specified, this must be noted on the Quote Form. Vendor must provide detailed specifications with the quote to document vendor's proposed substitute so that MAPC may evaluate accordingly. Failure to submit this documentation could result in the quote being rejected.

<u>SITE VISIT</u>

There will be a **mandatory** site visit for all interested vendors at the North Shore Regional 911 Center (18 Manning Avenue, Middleton, MA 01949) on Thursday, February 13th, 2020 at 9:30am.

The site visit will take place at the communications shelter next to the microwave tower across from the North Shore Regional 911 Center.

PROJECT TIMELINE

All services must be completed by May 15th, 2020. All vendors must confirm in their response that they are able to meet this deadline.

SCOPE OF WORK³

The selected vendor shall provide and install all required materials to provide electrical and fiber connectivity to a recently purchased and installed prefabricated communications shelter building.

¹ Vendors who comply with all requirements for submittal of quotes will be considered "Responsive."

² Vendors whose references are satisfactory to MAPC shall be considered "Responsible."

³ The naming of any commercial name, trademark, or other identification shall not be construed to exclude any item or manufacturer not mentioned by name or as limiting competition, but shall establish a standard of quality only. An item equal to one or more that are named or described in the Specifications may be offered by a vendor. An item shall be considered equal to the item so named or described if (1) it is at least equal in quality, durability, appearance, strength and design, (2) it will perform at least equally the function imposed by the general design for the use intended, and (3) it conforms substantially to the requirements of the specifications with only minor deviations immaterial to the requirements of the preceding conditions (1) and (2).



The selected vendor shall utilize existing conduct runs from the North Shore Regional 911 Center building to the communications pull box adjacent to the new communications shelter building.

The selected vendor shall provide cabling that adheres to RF (radio frequency) shielding and water intrusion standards.

The selected vendor shall:

- Run 2" conduit from existing UPS circuit to spare 6" conduit in raised floor in equipment room within the North Shore Regional 911 Center (NSR911).
 - Reduce 6" to 2" to complete run.
- Install one (1) electric pull box outside next to an existing communication pull box and redirect 6" spare conduit in and out to the communications shelter.
- At the shelter site, install one (1) electric pull box inside the fencing and redirect spare conduit and shelter power conduit into that pull box.
- Install two (2) 6U fiber splice junction boxes:
 - One (1) inside the communication room at the NSR911 main building
 - One (1) inside the communications shelter
- Run 72-strand ST-ST fiber from communication room to shelter.
- Loom and seed where earth has been disturbed.
- Re-stone fenced-in shelter area.

WARRANTY

The vendor shall warrant all work for a period of five (5) years after final acceptance of the work.

INSPECTION

Final acceptance of the work shall be subject to inspection and approval by NERAC/MAPC.

REFERENCES

Vendors must provide the following contact information for a minimum of 3 references that have received similar services from the vendor within the last 3 years, 2 of which must be government customers. A minimum of 1 of these references must have been active within the 12 months prior to this Request for Quotes due date. Use a separate sheet(s) clearly marked "REFERENCES" to provide the following information for each reference.

- 1. Customer Name
- 2. Years as a customer
- 3. Street
- 4. City, State, Zip
- 5. Contact Person
- 6. Telephone number

Poor references may be used as a basis for determining that a VENDOR is not responsible.

PAYMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED

Payments will not be made until services are complete and receipt is confirmed by NERAC and then not until MAPC receives reimbursement from the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPSS) for invoices submitted. The standard turnaround time for payment from the time of invoice approval and service acceptance is a minimum of 60 days.



PAYMENT BOND REQUIRED

If the contract price exceeds \$25,000, a payment bond will be required from the selected vendor. The payment bond must be in the amount of 50% of the contract price. Bond shall be conditioned upon the faithful performance of the contract. The bond must be obtained by the selected vendor from a surety company and guarantee payment to materials suppliers and/or subcontractors in the event that the selected vendor fails to pay the materials suppliers and/or subcontractors. This guarantee shall be submitted in the form of a good and sufficient bond drawn upon an Insurance or Bonding Company authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The selected vendor has 10 days from the date of notification of contract award to obtain the payment bond.

CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

The selected vendor shall secure and maintain in effect insurance coverage adequate to meet its obligations under this section and shall provide MAPC with certification of such as a condition of award if requested.

The work contracted for through this Request for Quotes is subject to the Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Law: M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 26 - 27; c. 5, § 1; c. 71, § 7A and c. 121B, § 29B. More information on the Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Law can be found on the Massachusetts Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development's website: http://www.mass.gov/lwd/labor-standards/prevailing-wage-program/. The vendor awarded this contract must comply with the Massachusetts laws regarding prevailing wage rates and must provide MAPC with certified payroll records within fifteen days after completion of its portion of the work, as well as a Statement of Compliance.

CONDITIONS OF ENGAGEMENT

The vendor's quote must cover and include the cost for all contingencies, including all labor and materials necessary for the delivery of services.

The selected vendor shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend NERAC, MAPC and the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPSS), their officers, agents, and employees from all liability of any nature or kind, including costs and expenses for all actions or claims resulting from injuries or damages sustained by any person or property arising directly or indirectly as a result of any error, omission or negligent or wrongful acts of the vendor, subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by them in performance of this contract.

TIE BREAKER

In the event of a low quote tie, MAPC will reach out to the consultants submitting the low quote and ask for a best and final quote. In the event that no revised quotes are received, the low quote shall be the consultant who wins a coin toss to take place within 24 hours of the deadline for quotes.

TERMINATION

Either MAPC or the selected consultant may terminate this Agreement for cause upon written notice given by the non-defaulting party. For the purposes of this provision, "cause" shall include the failure of a party to fulfill its material duties hereunder in a timely and proper manner.

General location of the communications shelter in relation to existing microwave tower site (not to scale).



Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

• This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.

• An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.

• The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.

• All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.

• The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.

• Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.

• Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.

• Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.

• Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and
