### **Group Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What do you value most about the Railroad Avenue area and the adjacent neighborhoods?
- 2. Given regional and national housing trends, where are the best opportunities for adding housing in this area?
- 3. What types of businesses could support the Downtown and surrounding neighborhoods?
  - Where might these businesses be located?
- 4. What transportation improvements could be made within the study area and to better connect this area to the Downtown and Harbor?
  - Specifically, what improvements could be made for pedestrians, cyclists and/or transit users?

#### **Suggested Ground Rules:**

- 1. Listen as an ally with respect and without interruptions or personal attacks.
- 2. One person speaks at a time. Avoid dominating the discussion so that everyone has an opportunity to contribute. Try to defer to an existing conversation thread.
- 3. Express your own views and do not attempt to speak for others.
- 4. Share information to help inform MAPC recommendations and City of Gloucester decisions. Ask questions of others to understand what they are saying and why.
- 5. It is perfectly OK to disagree, but remember, this is a discussion...not a debate. It is more important to help MAPC understand different perspectives than persuade someone else to agree with you.
- 6. Raise your hand to signal the facilitator(s) you wish to be recognized. Facilitators will do their best to take note of order in which members asked to be recognized.
