water guidelines, plan for and embark on regional service delivery, and many other projects that help communities work together to efficiently deliver services.

The Legislature and Governor appropriated **\$2.8 million** to the DLTA Fund for the past five years. In FY2019, we are requesting that DLTA be funded at **\$3.4 million**. This will allow the RPAs to continue to provide the wide range of services that our member municipalities require.
