

# Identify Opportunities

---

- Expand existing businesses
- Attract new businesses
- Upgrade commercial properties
- Include different types of development  
Mixed use; multi-family; affordable housing
- Improve site design  
Low Impact Development and “Green Streets”
- Increase pedestrian connections
- Develop and revitalize public spaces
- Increase the tax-base

## How Can the Town Guide Development?

### What controls development?

- Regulations
  - Zoning, for uses and dimensions, parking, signage
- Site conditions
  - Is the site built on, or is it vacant?
- Environmental conditions
  - Wetlands, aquifer and water protection
  - Wastewater disposal



Regulations can be written to:


1. Reduce setbacks from the street
2. Allow higher buildings
3. Provide for a mix of uses
4. Allow affordable and/or multi-family housing
5. Reduce parking requirements

- Exterior Materials:
  - Wood or brick
  - Adequate first floor windows to enhance visibility of shop spaces
- Parking: at rear of building where possible


- Pedestrian amenities:

- Use wide sidewalks/pathways
- Outdoor seating
- Appropriate landscaping
- Locate structures to maximize ease of pedestrian access




