

GENERATING LIMITED REVENUE – 7% V. RESIDENTIAL

POPULATION DECLINING WHILE AGING

41% LOSS OF JOBS
LOW JOBS PER RESIDENT RATIO - 0.2

DAYTIME SHOPPERS TOO LOW TO SUPPORT BUSINESSES

HOUSING AFFORDABILITY CHALLENGES

44% COST-BURDENED,

51% OF THOSE ARE SENIORS

7.7% SUBSIDIZED HOUSING INVENTORY — SHORT OF 10% MIN.

- 58% MIXED-USE RESIDENTIAL STRATEGY
- 55% TRANSFORMATIVE (CATALYTIC) REDEVELOPMENT
- 78% INFRASTRUCTURE-BASED FLOOD-RISK REDUCTION STRATEGIES
- 68% COASTAL RE-SANDING & EROSION-REDUCTION MEASURES
- 59% PARTIALLY SUBSIDIZED MBTA PASSES
 TO ENCOURAGE TRANSIT USE & REDUCE TRAFFIC
- **48% ENHANCED FERRY SERVICE**
