


Survey distribution


- 1,382 respondents! (compare that to a population of 11,000!)












Data from African American, Asian American, Latinx respondents







Data from respondents who rent




Most important improvements





"Safe place that has natural areas for walking and biking. Continued great educational system and strong community. More diversity."


"an historic, charming, open space town"

2004 Vision:

It is our Vision that the Town of Wrentham maintain and enhance a high quality of life, and be affordable, for all of its residential and corporate citizens. Wrentham citizens, their elected boards and appointed committees, will be guided by this Vision."
