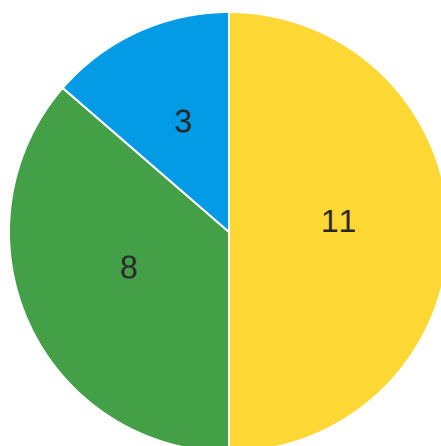


Q1 - What way do you prefer to attend Coalition Meetings? - Selected Choice

My preference is in-person but I am thankful for the option for those times when I have the time to attend but should not leave town.

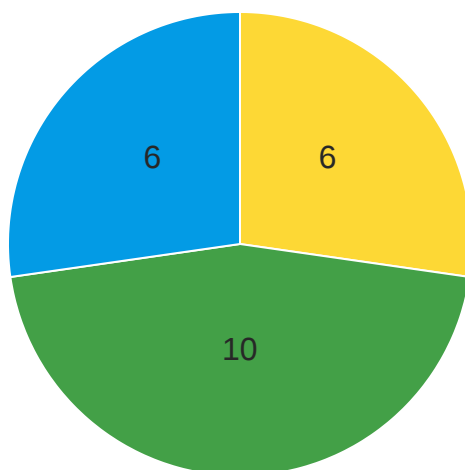
until the pandemic is ended, I prefer quarterly in person meetings and virtual for others (unless there is a major issue that we need to meet on in person.

short meetings and vary locations to be closer to different towns.

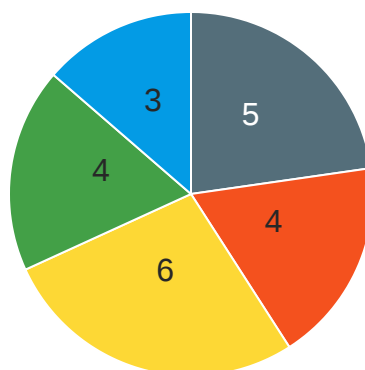

Q9 - In your opinion, how many Coalition Meetings should be held completely in-person annually?

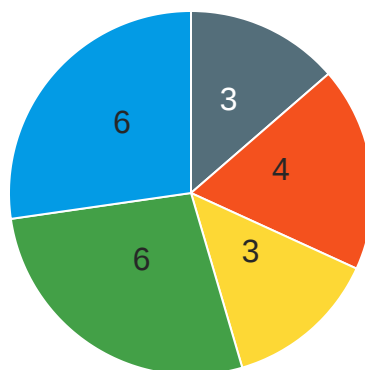
