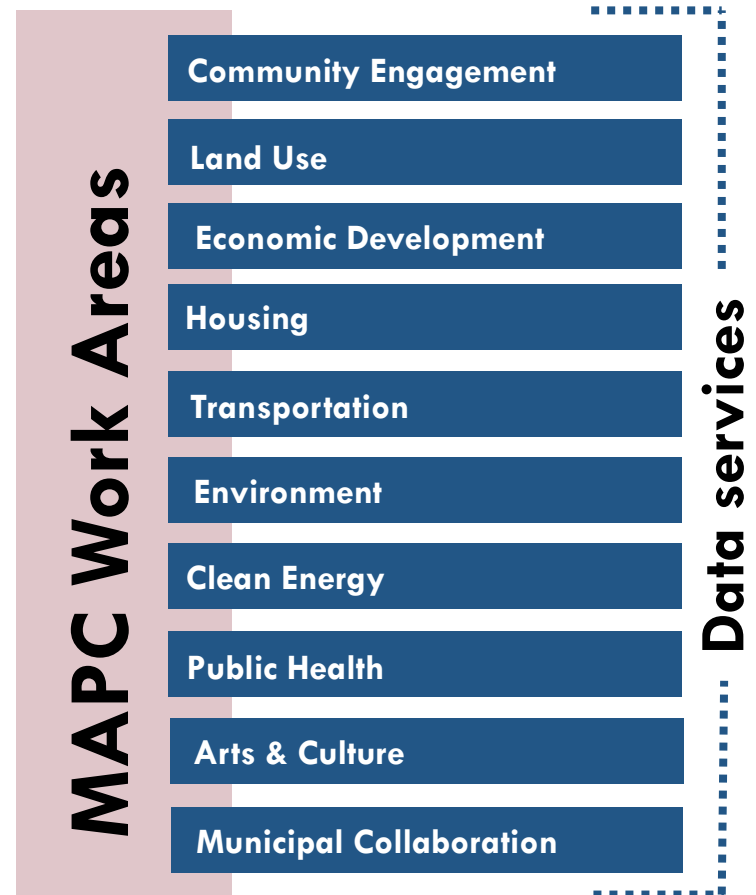

# What is TAP?

- Opportunity for cities and towns to leverage MAPC's expertise
- TAP grants fund MAPC staff time to work for communities
- All 101 cities and towns are eligible for TAP funding



# Program Details

## Funding Priorities

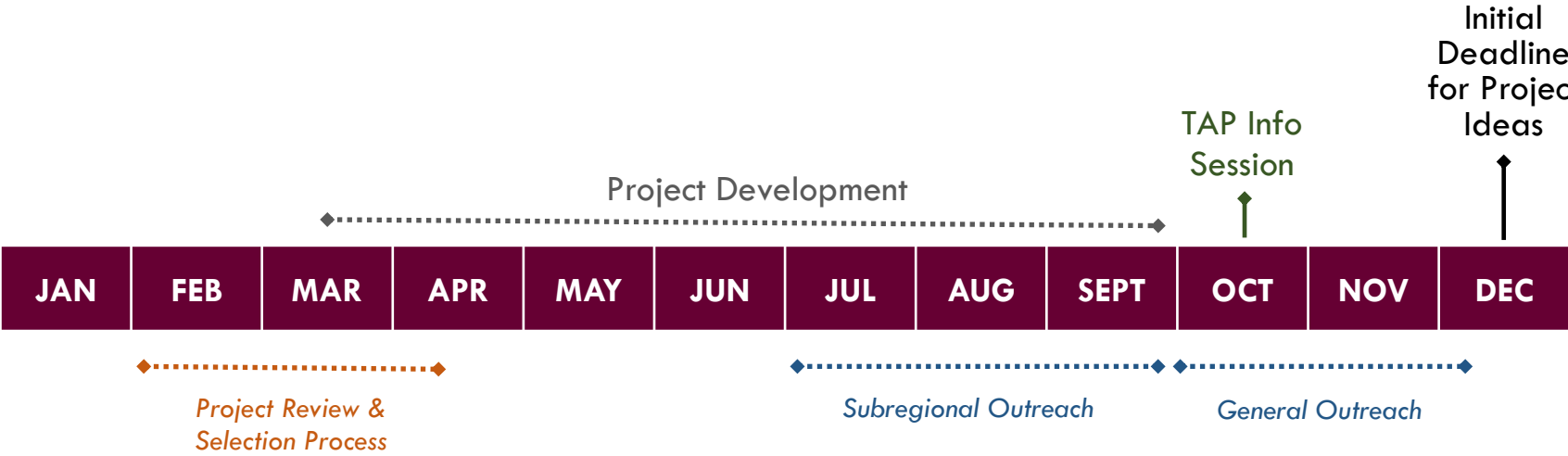
---

- Advances racial and social equity
- Involves multiple communities
- Implements regional and state priorities (MetroCommon2050, Housing Choice Initiatives, Community Compact Best Practices)

- Applicants **submit project ideas**
- Applicants encouraged to **reach out to MAPC staff** prior to submitting ideas
- **Grants awarded on an annual basis**
- **Awards vary** from \$5K to \$50K – depends on other project budget sources

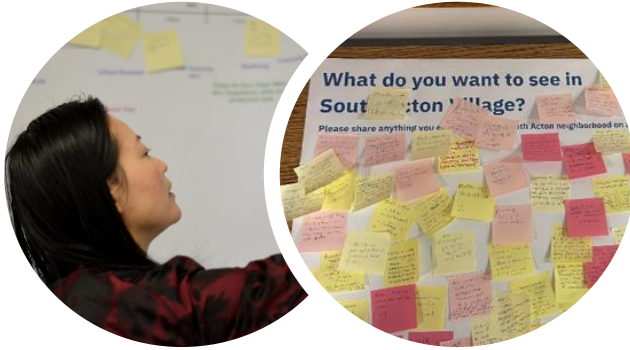
# Annual TAP Timeline



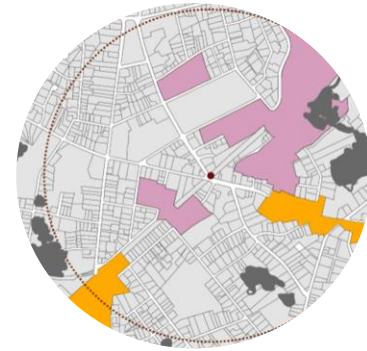
