- Work with Plan ambassadors


MAPC Project Team + Town Staff

Innovative and creative

Meaningfully engage community members by meeting people where they are to solicit feedback that will shape a plan for and by the Norfolk community



Full-circle communication

Ensure residents feel heard, feedback is shared in a timely manner with decision-makers, and residents understand how to remain involved in the project



Accessible and transparent

Ensure those with various abilities can be involved in all engagement opportunities, while avoiding over-burdening community members with requests



Dynamic and iterative

Remain nimble in the community engagement process, adapting strategies as the project progresses and more is learned about the community






