

SCULPTURE PROPOSAL

LEX 250 MONUMENT

MGA Sculpture Studio, led by artist Mark Aeling for the past 30 years, is based in St. Petersburg, Florida.

The 5,000 sq ft facility produces large scale public work all in-house, from concept to installation with a talented team of 8 artists.

Among the studio's notable creations are a 9/11 monument complete with a 25-foot copper phoenix wing and a true-to-life, 16,000-pound replica of the world's inaugural commercial flight in 1914.



ACTUAL FLINTLOCK


In our research, inspiration was found in Emerson's renowned phrase "THE SHOT HEARD ROUND THE WORLD" This led to an exploration of that pivotal moment, underscoring the notion that a solitary spark - a mere flicker of energy - can alter the trajectory of history. The flintlock emerged as the emblem, symbolizing the birth of the nation: tumultuous, explosive, and awe-inspiring.




Currently, we're exploring multiple iterations of the monument. This iteration features a blank placard with text TBD will use community and committee input to complete. Additionally, eagles are strategically placed amidst the sparks, as a symbol of the birth of liberty.

MGA has also opted to honor the Statue of Liberty by employing the same materials: verdigris patina and gilding. This serves as a nod and prelude to Lady Liberty and her lasting flame.
