## Historic Preservation Plan

### Project Background

The Stoneham Historical Commission is leading the development of a town-wide historic preservation plan in partnership with community stakeholders. The final plan will be a comprehensive document that outlines strategies and guidelines for safeguarding and maintaining historically significant buildings, landmarks, sites, or areas, aiming to protect Stoneham's cultural and historical heritage for future generations. This will be the Town of Stoneham's first community-wide preservation project since 1977 when the newly formed Stoneham Historical Commission conducted a large-scale survey of historic properties.
