

Identify Stoneham's existing historic resources and preservation stakeholders




Assess Stoneham's culture and history of preservation, including local policies



Establish a community **vision** for historic preservation in Stoneham



Develop an historic preservation plan with specific recommendations for implementation





Project Process

- + Review existing conditions
- + Assemble a historic resource inventory
- + Talk with key stakeholders
- + Draft a vision statement
- + Share findings and recommendations for feedback
- + Draft a **plan** to guide municipal preservation efforts








Project Methodology

+ Regular, transparent communication with project partners and the public


- + Robust public engagement with diverse stakeholders
