

Project Advisory. Expect Major Delays. May 30 - June 2 and June 20 - June 23

Newton-Weston Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation at I-90/I-95

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

In May and June of 2025, MassDOT will replace the I-90 bridge over the MBTA Worcester Commuter Rail in Newton, MA. Accelerated Bridge Construction methods will be used to replace the bridge over two weekends to minimize impacts to the public.

The First Rapid Replacement Weekend

**Friday May 30, 2025 9 p.m. to
Monday June 2, 2025 5 a.m.**

The Second Rapid Replacement Weekend

**Friday June 20, 2025 9 p.m. to
Monday June 23, 2025 5 a.m.**

TRAVEL IMPACTS

Highway: As vehicles approach the bridge, Eastbound and Westbound travel lanes will be reduced from three lanes to one. After passing through the work zone, vehicles will return to the normal traffic pattern along I-90. **Significant traffic impacts will be felt between Boston and Framingham.**

Commuter Rail: Buses will replace the last Worcester Commuter Rail train on Friday and replace all trains on Saturday and Sunday along the Worcester Commuter Rail Line between Framingham and South Station.

Amtrak: Buses will replace the last Amtrak train on Friday, all trains on Saturday and Sunday, and the first train on Monday along the Lake Shore Limited Route between Boston and Albany.



TRAVEL TIPS

Drivers should expect significant delays on I-90 during these weekends. If possible, drivers should plan ahead, avoid the area, and seek an alternate route.
